

Reach Academy Feltham 16-19 Tuition Fund 202122 Strategy

Reach Academy Feltham (UKPRN: 10037673) is eligible to receive £1,998 from this fund for small group tuition, in line with the [tuition fund guidance](#). A small group should be no more than 5 students for this purpose, in exceptional circumstances this may be extended to 7 students.

Statement

During the Autumn Term, Reach Academy Feltham will provide maths tutoring to 3 of our GCSE 'Take 2' students in Year 12. The two hour-long weekly tutoring sessions from September to November, plus extra revision sessions in the immediate run up to the exams has been made available to all pupils who are retaking their Maths GCSE qualification. The tutoring has been provided by one of our Maths teachers, and we have used our 16-19 tuition fund to cover some of these costs.

We will also be running catch up and extend/stretch masterclasses for pupils after their assessments in the Autumn term during the Spring to prepare them for exams. All students courses have been impacted by the pandemic and the tutoring will be to support the students to reach their full potential and target grades.
